

- Protected for 10 years renewable

Distinctive

Your own name
Original name /word / logo

Image or Personality Rights

Your Face – likeness, silhouette, profile

Name (nick-name)

Peculiar characteristics (poses, walk)
= Property = Value



Protect as (i) Trade Mark or (ii) Personality Rights












Image or Personality Rights


Robert Marley Foundation v. Dino Michelle Limited, 1994 celebrity personality gains property rights by reputation

'misappropriation of property rights'

image rights continue after death

Estate can exploit right even if Personality didn't exercise right during life
